Mission Statement:

"Our mission is to become individuals who are burning with a desire to praise God with great passion, spiritual discipline, and skillful musicianship, so that as a united team we can come together to bring a powerful overflow of God's worship in our church."

Minimum Qualifications:

1. **Character.** *No one is perfect. God's grace is one and the same for everyone regardless of one's moral aptitude. However, at the least, you must be a Christ confessing Christian who is sincere about making Jesus your Lord.*
2. **Chemistry.** *More damaging than an external attack is an internal disharmony that can destroy the team. You must always be willing to co-operate with others in the team with sincerity and honesty, in the good times as well as the bad.*
3. **Competency.** *You must not only be able to comfortably play your primary instrument, you must continue to seek to become better.*

Minimum Requirements:

1. **A committed member of the church for at least 6 months.** *Your role on the band should not be the sole reason that you attend church. Remember that the commitment you make is not just to this team but it is to the entire Mosaic community.*
2. **Regular participation in team small group meetings.** *Being a part of this team means that you are stepping into a position of leadership and great influence. This is why it is vital for us to grow in love and in faith together, always holding each other accountable.*
3. **Available and willing to serve in all worship opportunities.** *Life can get pretty busy and there will always be situations where you're unable to serve, but we expect that you will always try your best to prioritize your schedule to show dedication through consistency and punctuality.*

Commitment Duration:

We ask that the minimum commitment for all members to be at least 1 full year. Before joining the team, we ask that you carefully consider your ability to fulfill the minimum term. This, however, is not a guarantee of your position either. All members will be re-evaluated each year.

Team Schedules:

Rehearsals for Sunday worship are held on Saturdays at 9:00am in the main sanctuary. Setup for worship is at 10:45am and opening praise starts promptly at 11:30 am. Please be on time or make sure to notify the worship leader for that week if there are any changes in your schedule.

Code of Conduct:

1. **Attitude.** *Seek to be encouraging to your team in both your actions and your language. Be positive, energetic and full of excitement for what we're doing. Share your ideas and creativity. Take ownership over the band. Don't be afraid to step up and challenge the team towards excellence.*
2. **Attire.** *On Sundays we have the tough task of leading a very wide demographic range of people, with a variety of preferences when it comes to worship. Being on stage highlights you as an individual so just be conscious of what you're wearing. Try to be respectful to everyone by choosing to avoid attire that might be offensive. Dress presentably without having to compromise your personal style.*
3. **Lifestyle.** *This may be the toughest thing to address. We don't want to be legalistic but we also don't want leniency to compromise the seriousness of being a member of this team. Remember that you are still a leader outside of the church and your decisions may reflect on our team. Lead a life of integrity. If being on the team was made easy, than anyone could be on it.*
